The Cast:

The show will feature all of our dancers, but not all classes to keep the show to a shorter running time than our usual annual show.

Upper Juniors- Street, Tap and Musical Theatre

Seniors- Street, Jazz and Musical Theatre

Tickets:

Due to the smaller capacity of the studio theatre, it is important that we ensure a fair ticket sales process.

Automatically, all families with children performing are allocated 2 tickets. This means that without fail, every family has two seats in the audience. Links to purchase these tickets is on the website.

The deadline to buy these is Friday 1st November 2024. If by this date you have not claimed your two tickets, I will presume that they are not needed. After 1st November, I will then put all remaining available tickets on general sale, which will be available on a first come, first served basis. So, if you would like 4 tickets in total, you need to buy your initial two before 1st November. You can then buy your remaining 2 in the general sale. At this time, I don't know how many will be available in the general sale, but it is likely to be a small amount. As a result, please be considerate in not purchasing too many so that as many families as possible can access additional tickets. If you don't manage to get any more in the general sale, I am afraid that there won't be a possibility to access any more tickets unless anyone who has bought one no longer needs it. I will create a waiting list at that time if required.

There will be two performances on the day. As always, all performers are required to partake in both shows. I will randomly allocate your two spectator tickets to either show 1 or show 2. If, however, your allocation of show determines whether or not you are available, please state your preference in the registration form. I can't guarantee that I will be able to cater to it, but I will try my best! If you have any other requirement regarding the allocation of tickets to show 1 or 2, for example, you need one ticket in each show, please also state this in the registration form and I will do my best to accommodate you.

Costumes:

Unlike our annual show, there is no registration or additional rehearsal fee. We will be in costume, however to keep costs to a minimum, many of these will need to be supplied by yourselves using items you are likely to already have at home, or be able to cheaply and easily purchase. Costume is still in planning, and so I will release more information in a few weeks' time.

Make Up/ Hair:

Of course, show hair and makeup is a must! It's Christmas, so think glitter!

Hair-

Tippy Toes and Mini Stars- hair in a bun, tinsel around the bun

Lower Juniors- Hair in a bun, tinsel around the bun

Upper Juniors- Slick ponytail, tinsel around the bobble

Seniors- Half up, half down

Acrobats- Bun with tinsel (or whatever your other class requires)

Make up-

Unless there is an allergy, I suggest all dancers have bright red lipstick. You are welcome to do the rest of the make up to your personal preference. It's Christmas, so feel free to go mad with glitter!

On The Day:

Children will need to arrive at The Mac at 10.30am to register in. At this point, you'll be asked to leave them with us so that we can do quick practises, safety talks and settle into the backstage area. The first audience will enter The Foyle Studio at 12.45pm to watch the show. In between shows, performers will return to their changing areas for a break and so they do not need to be collected. During this time, we will welcome the second audience at 3.15pm for show 2. After the second show is finished, all performers will need to be collected.
